The Certificate IV in Alcohol and Other Drugs will give you the primary knowledge, skills and experience required to work with people experiencing alcohol and other drugs issues.

Work is undertaken in contexts such as organisations, withdrawal services, residential rehabilitation services and outreach services under the guidance of other practitioners and professionals, with limited responsibility and within established parameters.

The Australian Government is putting more resources into this area and the number of professionals required to work in this field is expected to increase three - fold over the next decade.
